

**SUMMARY**

For the Fire Engineers and Technicians Association (SITP), 2005 was a year of more intensified work in the scope the statutory activities of the units of the Association. Comparison with the organisational status in 2004 indicates growing trends, despite a decline in statutory activities in several small units. The tangible achievements of the Association included the seminars and conferences which it organised. As a total, 51 conferences and seminars were organised, in which about 4,800 persons participated. The publication of the SITP quarterly "Ochrona Przeciwpożarowa" ("Fire Protection") was successfully continued. The newly established Centre for Certifying Fire Protection Services, based in Poznań, granted certificates to the quality of fire protection services to 13 companies. Work was conducted on its own fire protection standards, primarily for fire signalling systems. Action was taken to appoint SITP experts. The Statute of the Association was also amended.
